We had the Elijah's who represent the first generation of preacher's the like of Benson Idahosa, Morris cerrullo, TI Osbon, Oral Roberts, Kenneth Hagin just to name few. These fathers raised the next generation of bishops and pastors the so called Elisha's of today by passing the mantle and funding, who have refused to raise the third generation of preachers instead they have cursed their sons and they are rising none as ministry is about them, some have mega churches when they die people will begin to fight for leadership control as they had raised none. God has enabled them have structures for raising money meant to fund the gospel by investing in the third generation of preachers, instead they have diverted the fund for jets and luxurious living while the third generation of pastors and Apostles have no support for ministry. The second generation of ministers most were funded from abroad, God also sent rich people to their churches to fund them, now they mock the third generation of preachers telling them, if God has called you He has to provide for you, this people have abandoned the call. Most of the upcoming ministers just like peter who told his fellow disciples I am going fishing have all gone back fishing to maintain their livelihoods as those second generation of ministers have diverted funding for the gospel to buying the latest model of cars, buying the next plot available, putting up mega building structures minus Standing to support the 5 gift Jesus left to build the church that is why the church looks weak and lost impact.

Elijah parted the water, he raised Elisha who had capacity to part the water, but Elisha lost that ability to pass the mantle to his son to part waters. The first generation of preachers walked in signs and wonders, the Elisha they raised do the same, but the Elisha of today have raised cripples, sons who can't even open the eyes of a blind man, The Elisha of today the second generation of bishops have destroyed that transfer of power, the first generation of bishops packed stadiums and arenas for God, the second generation did the same, but the second generation of bishops have raised sons who can't pack even a hall of 200 people, when they have 50 members in church they walk as if they own the whole world.

The second generation of bishops and pastors the modern day ministers have messed the original plan of God, the first generation of bishops had a very close walk with the second generation of

God's call cannot be limited to big denominational pastors and charismatic churches, where you keep pouring your money as some of them have no need for that money, where money is needed most we don't fund.

This neglected pastors and evangelist reach people who will never be reached by big denominational pastors and charismatic pastors who have mega churches.

This neglected pastors preach on streets, in buses, bus stops, packs, do house to house evangelism, start churches in villages, in remote areas their impact is well known in heaven while we see them as nothing or not called because they don't drive big machines, nor are not well fed, wear nice suits, live in porch areas, preach on TV, these people are doing the true ministry where it matters most. These are the current John the Baptists we despise but are honored by God. They preach where Jesus preached, in the streets, in remote areas, while Pharisees waited for people in the synagogues to bring more money. Look at the true ministries of the early Apostles, Stephen was preaching on the street where he was killed, look at peter James and john the preached outside, look at Philip he was out there in the desert where he met a man who needed salvation, people who need salvation are

outside the church that is where the true harvest is. The commission of Jesus is clear, go ye out to the high ways and the by ways, this people we despise and call brief case ministers are busy fulfilling that call, while those with big assemblies walk with body guards and are not ready to reach those in the streets where Christ send us. Kenya Gospel Mission funds seek to support all these gospel ministers neglected in the field, yet the impact they do is only known in heaven. Some started churches in remote areas and can't afford to buy church seats or church equipment, all those souls they lead are needed in heaven, some require funds to travel to minister and can't afford fare, some can't afford food for their families, some of their churches the roofs are leaking etc. It's time we stood to fund this initiative.
